

Code of Conduct
For all contributors to commonsense.eu and ancillary outputs

The editorial team has set the following code of conduct to govern all content of the website, as well as ancillary products such as the facebook page **CommonspaceEU** and twitter feed, **@commonsenseEU** as well as the **Concise** newsletters and **podcasts**

All contributors should be guided by the principals of tolerance, free speech and respect for diverse opinions.

Any material which inflames racial, religious or political hatred; shows disrespect due to race, religion, gender, sexual orientation and cultural identity; or is deemed pornographic or libellous shall be excluded.

In voicing diverse opinions, contributors will nevertheless avoid insulting language or language that may incite hatred, or unlawful violence.

Material placed on commonsense.eu shall be clearly attributable to the source from where it originates in a way that responsibility for the content shall be clearly with the person/organisation originating the content.

Contributors shall take care to quote correctly and honestly any person or document quoted or cited and shall take care to ensure that material translated from other languages is done so in an accurate and professional manner.

In reporting events, contributors will seek to be accurate and shall avoid sensationalism.
